### Abstract

'Doughnut Economics' envisions an economy that aims to meet the needs of all people within the means of the living planet. How does this differ from more traditional economic approaches and what does it start to look like in practice? In this talk Kate Raworth, author of the book *Doughnut Economics: seven ways to think like a 21<sup>st</sup> century economist*, will introduce the core concepts, with a focus on how they inform ways of thinking about climate change. She will also share examples from a wide range of places around the world that are starting to put the concept into practice particularly through the work of local government.

Kate Raworth is an economist focused on making economics fit for the 21st century's social and ecological realities. She is the author of the best-selling book *Doughnut Economics: seven ways to think like a 21<sup>st</sup> century economist*, which has been published in over 20 languages.
